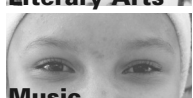
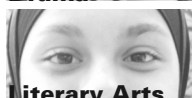
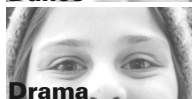
Winners will be notified in late April.
