FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Funding is distributed on a first-come, first-served basis to eligible schools and community venues.

No application is required. Simply indicate your interest on the online booking form, and we will confirm your eligibility based on our funding guidelines. Please note that this funding provides a subsidy toward the program fee; the venue will be responsible for the remaining balance.

SHSM PROGRAMS

MASC offers hands-on, arts-based master classes that support the Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) in Arts and Culture. Led by professional artists, our programs help students gain real-world experience.

Workshops can cover a wide range of SHSM certification areas, including:

- *Advanced training in art forms*
- *Curatorial techniques and event coordination*
- *Sector-specific software (e.g., animation, graphic design, video production, dubbing, photography)*
- *Audition preparation, technical staging, and sound/lighting equipment*
- *Portfolio development, grant writing, and leadership skills*

2nd SHSM ARTS & CULTURE CONFERENCE

To further support SHSM students, MASC also hosts an annual **SHSM Arts & Culture Conference** each February. This one-day experiential learning event brings together students from across Ontario for advanced, hands-on workshops led by professional artists, career pathway discussions, and networking opportunities. Participants earn their **SHSM certification in Advanced Training in a Technique** through immersive workshops aligned with many of the certification areas listed above, while gaining valuable insight into careers in the arts and culture sector.

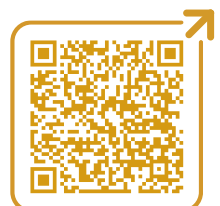


MASC Young Authors & Illustrators Festival

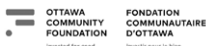
