If a venue cancels a confirmed Residency for any reason, they must contact both MASC and the artist. The artist's contact information is on the MASC Confirmation form.

### **DEFINITIONS**

#### **Residency:**

MASC programs that include activities on three days or more.

## **IMPORTANT NOTE**

Severe weather conditions: MASC artists are not required to travel to the venue if they deem it unsafe to do so. In these circumstances, we ask the artist to contact the school to discuss this at the earliest possible time. This will not constitute a cancellation on behalf of MASC.





# **CANCELLATION POLICY**

### FOR RESIDENCIES

in Public Health safety protocols, venue closures, power failures, illness related outbreaks, lockdown or fire

(including drills) etc.

# **AS APPLIED TO VENUES**

If a venue cancels a confirmed MASC booking for any reason, they must contact **both** MASC and the artist. The artist's contact information is on the MASC Confirmation form.

Notice of Cancellation	Remaining activities are rescheduled with the same artist*	Remaining activities are NOT rescheduled with the same artist*
Within 11-20 business days, prior to the first booking day.	A 10% per day surcharge for remaining activities will be added to the rescheduled invoice and credited to the artist.	Venue will be charged 20% per day of the remaining activities, which will be credited to the artist. Plus 100% cost of materials fees incurred by the artist at the time of cancellation.
Within 0-10 business days, prior to the first booking day (including lockdown and fire drills).	A 30% per day surcharge for remaining activities will be added to the rescheduled invoice and credited to the artist.	Venue will be charged 50% per day of the remaining activities, which will be credited to the artist. Plus 100% cost of materials fees incurred by the artist at the time of cancellation.
Force Majeure: strike actions, bus cancellations, severe weather conditions, changes	No surcharge	No charge will be made to the venue, and no payment will be made to the artist.

<sup>\*</sup>MASC will also bill the venue, and reimburse the artist, for 100% of any transportation, material or equipment rental expenses incurred that cannot be reversed.





## FOR RESIDENCIES

# **AS APPLIED TO MASC ARTISTS**

If an artist cancels a confirmed Residency for any reason, they must contact **both** the venue and MASC. The venue's contact information is on the MASC Confirmation form.

Notice of Cancellation	Remaining activities are rescheduled	Activity is not rescheduled with the same artist*
Within 11-20 business days, prior to the first booking day.	No surcharge	\$25 per day (capped at \$125) of the scheduled residency will be deducted from artist's next payment and credited to the venue.
Within 1-10 business days, prior to the first booking day.	\$25 per day (capped at \$250) of the rescheduled residency will be deducted from the artist's next payment and credited to the venue.	\$50 per day (capped at \$500) will be deducted from artist's next payment and credited to the venue.
Cancellation day of or Failure to appear	\$50 per day (capped at \$250) of the scheduled residency will be deducted from the artist's next payment and credited to the venue.	\$75 per day (capped at \$750) will be deducted from artist's next payment and credited to the venue.
Force Majeure: severe weather conditions, changes in Public Health safety protocols, illness, death in the family, accident, etc.	No charge will be made to the venue, and no payment will be made to the artist. MASC will make every effort to reschedule the event.	No charge will be made to the venue, and no payment will be made to the artist. MASC will make every effort to reschedule the event.

<sup>\*</sup>If the artist has been paid for the booking and there is no future payment due to the artist, the artist will be expected to reimburse MASC this amount, which will then be credited to the venue within a timeframe discussed with MASC.
